Training shall be regularly refreshed at no less than annual intervals. The training must be recorded and be accessible on the premises and made available for inspection upon request of a Police Officer or an authorised officer of the licensing authority or (in the case of online training) within 48 hours.
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
A CCTV system will be in operation at the premises and recorded images shall be retained for a period of 31 days. CCTV images will be provided to the police and other responsible authorities as soon as practicable and in any case within 48 hours of a request for such images, subject of the provisions of the DPA.
c) Public safety
An incident register will be maintained at the premises and made available to the authorities on request.
d) The prevention of public nuisance
A register of refusals of alcohol will be maintained at the premises. The register will be made available for inspection by the Police and other responsible authority.
All licensable activities in the beer garden will end at 23:00 on every day.
e) The protection of children from harm
The premises will adopt a 'Challenge 25' policy. This means that if a customer purchasing


